



Advice for refugees and asylum-seekers on the Mobile Registration Exercise conducted by UNHCR

The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) is undertaking a Mobile Registration exercise for unregistered asylum-seekers in Malaysia.

- ❖ This exercise will be held in stages, in several locations across Malaysia, and will take place from 2 September 2013 through to the end of the year/early 2014.
- ❖ The purpose of this exercise is to register some populations of unregistered asylum-seekers found to be in need of international protection.
- ❖ Only unregistered asylum-seekers who are already in Malaysia and whose names are already on UNHCR's list will be registered during this exercise.
- ❖ The persons who are on the list will be contacted directly by UNHCR and will be given a Code and information on where they should go for the exercise.
- ❖ If you were given a Code but cannot remember the location of where you should go, you can call the Mobile Registration Hotline at 0126534791 and 0126534826, which operate from 8am – 10pm every day.
- ❖ Only asylum seekers who have received the Code by UNHCR before the start of the exercise will be registered. Asylum-seekers who come to the venue without the code that was given by UNHCR will not be registered and are asked to wait for the next exercise.
- ❖ Please remember that all services provided by UNHCR for refugees are free.
